Stmr Oldenburg, (Ger.) Gathemann, from Bremen, passengers and merchandise; to A. Schumacher & Co. Left Bremerhaven May 12, at 1 P. M., with passengers and cargo; passed the Weser Light-Vessel at 3.40 P. M. the same day, Dover the next day at 12.30 P. M., Lizard 14th, and arrived at Cape Henry May 24, at 11.17 P. M. In the North sea and English channel had moderate winds, with lazy weather; afterward, to the Banks of New Foundland, frequently fresh and strong westerly winds, with rough sea and rain-squalls. Off the Banks to Cape Henry had fair weather, with moderate winds and sea. Spoke on May 21, in lat. 42.18 N., lon. 52.20 W., Norwegian bark H. F. V. T., bound north: on 22d, in lat. 40.37 N., 66.30 W., the N. G. Lloyd stmr Aller, bound out. Stmr Carthaginian, (Br.) France, from Liverpool,
