

**BROTHER OF O. W. FAIL DEAD**

**Geo. W. Fail Succumbed at Butler, Missouri, August 30.**

Last week's edition of the **Butler, Missouri, Democrat**, contained the following account of the death of **George W. Fail**, a brother of **O. W. Fail**, formerly district clerk, but now a resident of **Baxter Springs**:

**George W. Fail** died at his home in **Butler** at mid-night **Thursday, August 30, 1917.**

**George W. Fail** was born in **Schuyler County, Missouri**, **September 29, 1869**, and spent his young manhood in that county and **Harrison County**. About thirteen years ago he moved with his family to **Bates County** and lived for a number of years on a farm near **Foster**, and later on a farm east of **Amoret**. One year ago ill health compelled him to abandon farming, and he removed to this city where he has since resided. While here he made many friends who learned to respect in him a character of fair-mindedness and high ideals. He leaves a wife and two daughters, **Mrs. Marvel Moorwood of Amsterdam** and **Doris Fail of this city**, besides a father and eight sisters and three brothers to mourn his loss. His wife and younger daughter and father and sister, **Mrs. S. N. Kinion of this city**, were with him at the time of death.

Funeral services were conducted by **H. O. Maxey** at two o'clock **Saturday afternoon** at the late residence, **405 N. Lyon Street**. Burial was in **Oak Hill cemetery**.
