Samuel Nelson Kinion was born October 21, 1865, in Harrison County, Missouri and died at the Butler hospital, October 26, 1937.

In 1883, he was married to Sarah Fail and to this union, six children were born. Two are deceased and those surviving are: Mrs. Robert O'Rear of Hume, Mo.; Mrs. F. E. Mollenhauer, of Kansas City; Mrs. Richard Nicholson, of Wichita, Kas.; and Claude Kinion of Warrensburg, Mo. There are twelve grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.
