

Nicholas John Bingle was born Jan. 20, 1878, near Mamarock, Germany, and passed away at the Nevada hospital at 1:05 p. m. on June 16, at the age of 70 years, 5 months and 14 days. He had been in failing health for the last year, but was bedfast only a few days. Mr. Bingle moved to Metz 43 years ago and was employed by the Missouri Pacific railroad for over 30 years.
