Former Tinley Man Killed By Train

William G. Canter, 55, a former resident of Tinley Park, was killed Thanksgiving Eve when struck by an elevated train in Chicago.

A sergeant in the C.T.A. police department in Chicago, Mr. Canter was making an investigation with two other officers on a report of suspicious persons in the area of the Congress st. elevated.

He had stepped down from the platform to search underneath when hit by a train.

Funeral services were held Saturday and burial is in St. Joseph's cemetery.

He is survived by the widow, Genevieve, a son Robert, and two grandchildren.

Until moving to Chicago about a year ago, Mr. Canter lived at 17601 S. 65th ave., in Tinley Park.

Several years ago he was a candidate in the village election for police magistrate.
