

Arrived.

Steamship *Adriatic*, Comstock, Havre Aug. 1, with mdse. and passengers to North Atlantic Steamship Co. Arr. off Battery at 8:30 A. M. Aug. 10, lat. 40 38, lon. 69, passed ship *Philadelphia*, from Liverpool for Philadelphia.

Steamship *Delaware*, Cannon, Philadelphia and Cape May, with mdse. and passengers to F. Perkins.

Steamer *Penguin*, Williams, Providence, with mdse. to Isaac Odell.

Steamer *Bristol*, Allen, Philadelphia, with mdse. to Loper & Kirkpatrick.

Ship *Escort*, Hussey, Liverpool 35 ds. with mdse. and 164 passengers to David Ogden. July 10, signalized Am. brig *Purlo*, bd. E. 11th, signalized Fr. bark *Lydia*, bd. E.; also Span. brig *Fleur de Maria*, bd. E. July 25, lat. 42, lon. 33 40, saw a large Am. whaling bark painted white, lying to under foresail and spanker, with three boats in davits on the port side. Also another Am. whaling bark, painted black, cruising in co.; plenty of whales around. Aug. 6, lat. 41 15, lon. 64 05, at 6 P. M., saw Br. steamship *Vigo*, bd. E. Aug. 9, 97 miles E. of Sandy Hook, took pilot from boat E. Forrest, No. 14.

Ship *William Tell*, Funck, Havre July 1, with mdse. and 382 passengers to Boyd & Hincken. July 19, lat. 44, lon. 29, was boarded by the captain of whaling bark *Statina* of New Bedford, on a cruise, was out 33 months. Had 2,400 bbls. oil and 18 000 lbs. bone; all well.

Ship *Emerald Isle*, Cornish, Liverpool July 5, with mdse. and 685 passengers to Tapscott & Co. Had 2 births and 1 death on the passage.

Ship *Carolus Magnus*, Ashby, Liverpool July 6, with mdse. to Wm. Whitlock, Jr. Is anchored on the Bay.
