

PATRICK MOYLAN, AGED WILTON MAN, CALLED BY DEATH

WILTON, Ia., Oct. 22.—(Special)
—Patrick Moylan, 86 years of age, a pioneer resident of Muscatine county and a resident of Wilton for the past 15 years, died at the Hershey hospital in Muscatine Saturday evening at 9:30 o'clock. He had been confined at the hospital for two weeks, but had been in failing health for the past year. Infirmities of old age caused his death.

Mr Moylan was born in Tipperary, Ireland, Jan. 20, 1837, and came to the United States locating in Goshen township, Muscatine county, when a child with his parents. He resided on a farm in Boshen township until 15 years ago when he retired and moved to Wilton.

Funeral services were held from the home of his daughter, Mrs R. E. Marticke of Wilton at 8 o'clock. The Rev. Father M. P. Kirkpatrick, pastor of the church, conducted the services. Interment was in the St. Mary's cemetery at Wilton.

Surviving are four daughters, Mrs R. E. Marticke of Wilton, Mrs William White, Mrs Henry Schmidt and Mrs May McFadden and one son, James, all of Atalissa, Ia. His wife preceded him in death six years.
