

Will of Katherine Prymek

I know all men by their presents that I Katherine Prymek of Washington County, State of Iowa being of sound disposing mind and memory and of full age do hereby make public and declare this my last will and testament in the manner following, that is to say.

- First: I direct that a monument be erected at my grave to cost at least the sum of three hundred dollars.
- Second: I direct that all my just debts including funeral expenses expenses of my last sickness and the expenses of administration be first paid out of my estate.
- Third: I give devise and bequeath to my son William Prymek the sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to him by my executor one year after my death out of my estate.
- Fourth: I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Emma Chilly the sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to her by my executor out of my estate, one year after my death.
- Fifth: I give devise and bequeath to my three grand children some being the three children of my daughter Elva Vindler the sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to them by my executor out of my estate, one year after my death, said children to divide the said five hundred dollars in three equal shares.
- Sixth: I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Katherine Raht, the sum of eight hundred dollars, to be paid to her by my executor out of my estate one year after my death.
- Seventh: I give devise and bequeath to my brother Frank Pittner of Iowa City, Iowa the sum of five hundred dollars, to be paid to him by my executor out of my estate one year after my death.
- Eighth: I give devise and bequeath to my servant Joseph Heck the sum of fifty dollars to be paid to him by my executor out of my estate one year after my death.
- Ninth: I give devise and bequeath all the residue and remainder of my estate real or personal to the following my children to wit: Frank Prymek, Joseph Prymek, Charles Prymek, Mary Trebs, and Anna Flynn they to share said remainder herein devised to them in equal shares, share and share alike.
- Tenth: I hereby appoint my son Frank Prymek the executor of this my last will and testament, and direct that he be not required to give any bond as such executor.

I, Elizabeth Wuethrich of Washington County Iowa being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making null and void all former wills by me made.

- First: My will is that all of my just debts and expenses of last sickness shall be paid out of my estate as soon as possible.
- Second: I give devise and bequeath unto my husband Michael Wuethrich the sum of One Dollar.
- Third: I give devise and bequeath unto my children, Godfrey, Gustave, William, and Lonke Wuethrich, and Elizabeth Goff, Lena Wiffeneger and Loring Palmenstein, and their heirs forever all of the balance of my property both real and personal of which I may die possessed.
- Fourth: I hereby appoint Frank Palmenstein the administrator of this my last will and testament, and hereby request that no bond be required or no appraisal be had of my estate.
