his mother, then a widow, moved to Cato, Cayuga
Co. Subsequently at age 17 he moved to Hannibal,
Oswego co. N. Y. residing there til 1847 when he
came to Mich. & located on a farm near the village
of Hudson, which he conducted about 4 yrs., since
which time he has resided in this village, engaging
in business til 1867 when he formed a partnership
in the banking business with HON. J. M. OSBORN,
WM. B. AMES, WM. B. THOMPSON & G. I. THOMPSON, firm
name of OSBORN, PERKINS & CO. in which bus. he
has since continued - firm name being changed &
now known as PERKINS, THOMPSON & CO. over.

He was m. twice; 1st on 17 Mar. 1842 to MARGARET PERKINS, dau. of JOB & PHEBE PERKINS & of the 3 sons by this union, 2 survive--the eldest JOHN C. having died from disease contracted in the Army during Civil war. MRS. PERKINS d. in Hudson Feb. 18, 1850. Jan. 19, 1853 he m. MRS. PHEBE S. HALL of Medina & this county, who survives him. In early life, with a widowed mother & 2 sisters to support he was obliged to practice rigid economy which habits formed, assisted him to acquire a competency & to retire from actual manual labor, as demanded by years & poor health. His active life here formed no inconsiderable part of the history of this town for the last 35 yrs.
